It is recognized that the primary function of a school is to provide an education and that extra-curricular involvement is a privilege extended to those students at Kal who uphold the code of conduct. The purpose of this academic policy is to ensure that any student's involvement in athletics does not detract from the main objective of academic achievement. It is essential that any student athlete maintains a minimum academic level of performance. Therefore, Kal maintains an academic eligibility policy which is as follows:

- Students must attend classes on a regular basis
- At each progress point and/or as teachers come forward to the Administration or Athletic Director, athletes who are having academic difficulty will be identified and met with.
- If an athlete is failing a course, they will be ineligible to play or attend practice/games until the course is being passed.

An important mission of the varsity athletics program is to teach and reinforce values relating to sportsmanship, competition, and fair play. It is expected that team personnel, parents, and spectators respect this mission by exhibiting appropriate behavior at athletic events. Part of sportsmanship means that players understand that coaches establish playing time, player rules, and practices to govern the sport in which they are volunteering to coach. It is also expected that parents and athletes treat all stakeholders (officials, coaches, scorekeepers, etc.) with respect and act as role models for each other in how to behave.

Students must travel with the team unless being driven by their own parents. Students may not drive themselves or get a ride to an event from anyone that is not approved in advance by the administration of the school. Any student that travels to an event with someone other than their own parents or the school arranged transportation will not be permitted to play. At the end of and during events, students cannot be released from the care of the coach/supervisor to anyone other than the student's parents. If an extraordinary situation occurs where a student needs to travel with someone other than parents or the school arranged transport, arrangements must be made prior to the event, not the day of, as administration approval is required, and paperwork must be filed at the school prior to departure.

Uniforms

Uniforms are provided by the school. Players are responsible for the uniform for the season and should take proper care in maintaining the uniform. All uniforms need to be laundered in cold water and hung to dry. Athletes will be responsible for any lost uniforms or any uniform that is damaged beyond normal wear and tear. No uniforms for any sport will be distributed to athletes until all previous uniforms are returned to the athletic department. School uniforms are to be only worn during competitions, not during gym class.
