Participation in school athletics is a privilege. Students wishing to participate in the athletics program at Kalamalka Secondary need to show a commitment to the program by regular attendance at practices and competitions, as well as following the SD22, Kal, & OVSAA codes of conduct (Okanagan Valley Sport Athletic Association).

### Academics

The primary function of a school is to provide an education. Extra-curricular involvement is a privilege extended to those students at Kal who uphold the code of conduct. It is essential that any student athlete maintains a minimum academic level of performance:

- Students must attend classes on a regular basis
- If teachers come forward to the Administration or Athletic Director with athletes who are having academic difficulty, a meeting will occur.
- **If an athlete is failing a course, they will be ineligible to play or attend practice/games until the course is being passed.**

### Sportsmanship

An important mission of the varsity athletics program is to teach and reinforce values relating to sportsmanship, competition, and fair play. Part of sportsmanship means that players understand that coaches establish playing time, player rules, and practices to govern the sport in which they are volunteering to coach. It is also expected that parents and athletes treat all stakeholders (officials, coaches, scorekeepers, etc.) with respect and act as role models for each other in how to behave.

Athletic fees and team fees are due at the start of the season. It is expected that once a student signs up for a team and attends practices they are committed to that athletic program. **Fees will not be reimbursed if a student decides not to continue with a team after a roster is created and practices have commenced. Fees will not be reimbursed if a student is suspended from a team.**

### Uniforms

Uniforms are provided by the school. Players are responsible for the uniform for the season and should take proper care in maintaining the uniform. All uniforms need to be laundered in cold water and hung to dry. Athletes are responsible for the cost associated with any lost uniforms or any uniform that is damaged beyond normal wear and tear. No uniforms for any sport will be distributed to athletes until all previous uniforms are returned to the athletic department. School uniforms are to be only worn during competitions, not during gym class. **Any uniform not returned before June 1<sup>st</sup> of the school year will need to be replaced. A \$100 fee per uniform will be assessed to the student's MyEd account.**
